

# The Logistics of Extracting a Completely Seized Vehicle

When an automobile is parked indefinitely, it essentially fuses itself to the ground. The extraction of a completely seized vehicle is not a simple towing job; it is a heavy recovery operation that requires specialised machinery, precise physics, and experienced operators. The first major obstacle is always the wheels. Over time, rubber tyres dry rot, crack, and lose all structural integrity, deflating completely until the heavy metal rims are resting directly on the ground. Positioning a heavy flatbed truck to achieve the correct pulling angle requires exceptional skill. If the winch cable is pulled at the wrong trajectory, it can cause the dead vehicle to swing violently sideways, potentially striking the house, a fence, or another parked car. The operator must calculate the exact line of tension needed to drag the dead weight safely out of its confined space.

To overcome these physical limitations, professional recovery teams employ specific techniques. Instead of relying on the car's seized wheels, operators often use heavy-duty recovery skates. These are specialised, low-friction platforms that are hammered under the locked tyres. Once the vehicle is resting on the skates, the winch can pull the car up the inclined bed of the truck smoothly, regardless of whether the brakes are entirely fused. This prevents the terrible screeching of dragging metal and protects the surface of your driveway from being gouged by locked rims.
